Regulations game operation (english translation from German)

1. Purpose

- The regulations regulate the entire game operation and are intended to prevent any differences of opinion.
- For the settlement of detailed questions, the annual program is also sent to all members at the beginning of the season.

2. Responsibility for the operation of the game

- The responsibility for the entire game operation lies with the captain (head of the game commission and member of the board).

3. Eligible Members

- Individual members
- Day players (time restriction Monday to Sunday 07.00 - 18.00 h)
- Juniors (Swiss Tennis considers juniors to be anyone who does not reach the age of 19 by 31 December of a current year.)
- Trial members

4. Guests

- Members can invite a guest to play from Monday to Sunday without any time restrictions. Each guest must be recorded with first name/surname/mobile number in the reservation system.
- Use of the tennis court for the guest per occupancy is CHF 10.00 and will be charged to the member at the end of the season.

5. Place regulations

- Playing possibilities and restrictions as well as playing time and court reservation according to the reservation system. Each eligible member receives the access authorization to the reservation system.
- Playing times: Daily 07.00 - 23.00 h (exception for day players 07.00 - 18.00 h)
- During the daily care, the corresponding courts are blocked. The playability of the courts is decided by the groundskeeper or the captain. Respective information in the reservation system and on the homepage.
- Playing time for singles and doubles is 60 minutes.
- Reservations of multiple hours are not allowed by the same player.
- In case of large crowds, only doubles are played.
- If the courts are not playable due to drought etc., they must be watered (if necessary brushed beforehand) - the instructions of the groundskeeper must be strictly followed.
- Court reservations for official events and training are recorded in the reservation system.
- It may only be played in tennis shoes.
- Tennis dress and tracksuits are allowed as clothing. Naked torso are not allowed (etiquette).
- These court regulations are binding for all tennis players.

6. Club Championships

- All members are eligible to participate.

7. Interclub Games

- The captain is responsible for the Interclub games. He coordinates the home games.

The present Regulations for Game Operations replace the previous regulations - the Game Regulations, the Ranking Regulations and the Course Regulations - of 23 March 2006. All 3 previous documents have been amended and summarized in a contemporary manner.
